Text of your abstract (style Normal: Times New Roman - 8pt - plain - justified)

Authors are asked to submit a one-page abstract in a two-column format. The first column should contain text only, while the second one should contain references, tables, formulas, graphs or photographs. Both text and figures must fit within a page frame of 257 mm (Width) x 165 mm (Height). The column width is 122 mm and the inter-column spacing is 13 mm. Pages should not be numbered.

Please use this template to start writing your abstract, so that the page setup is correct: paper size set to A4 (top and bottom margins are 22.5mm ; left and right margins are 20mm).

Figures:

- Please include figures directly in the text as jpeg or png figure. However, do not exceed the limit of a one-page abstract.




Figure 1. Insert concise explanation of figure 1 here. Figure may be color or grey scale (font style Centered: Times New Roman – 8pt – plain - centered)




Figure 2. Photographs and pictures must be of good quality color or grey scale.

- Photographs and pictures must be of impeccable grey-scale quality. Figures should be referenced in the text (see Figs 1 and 2). Handwritten lettering on figures is not acceptable. They should have a short caption directly underneath with a concise explanation of the figure or photo. (style Centered: Times New Roman - 8pt - plain - centered).

References: The reference list should be placed in square brackets and written as in the examples given hereafter for articles in journals [1], books [2], papers in a contributed volume [3], and thesis or unpublished work [4]. However, please limit the number in order not to exceed the limit of a one-page abstract.

Please convert your final Word file to Pdf.




Figure 3. Stretch to 50% in *MS Paint* reduces the size of your image by a factor 4 (e.g. 1MB becomes 250KB upon saving your image). Use this reduced image to import in Word.




Figure 4. Resize to 50% of original in *Adobe PhotoShop* reduces the size of your image by a factor 4 (e.g. 1MB becomes 250KB upon saving your image). Use this reduced image to import in Word.

- Please resize your figures before importing them to Word, to conform to maximum size of 10 MB pdf file. Resizing is attainable in all common image software (e.g. *MS Paint* uses Image - Stretch, *Adobe PhotoShop* uses Image Size as shown in Figs 3 and 4)
- Abstracts should be submitted on-line via <https://www.conftool.pro/mne2020>. Abstracts submitted via fax or e-mail will not be accepted.
